

# Homework - Year 1 Summer 2 2026

Every Week

Each week a list of words from the common exception spellings from Year 1 will be sent home for children to learn. At the end of each half term, children will be given a spelling test of 10 random words from the list.

Children will bring home a reading book that they have practised and rehearsed in school. Please listen to their reading so that they can show-case it to you— we ask that you read for 10 minutes each day.

Children will bring home a library book that they have chosen. This is an unfamiliar text that should be read to them. Please encourage enjoyment through looking at the pictures and talking about the book.

Each week a Little Wandle home learning sheet will be shared, detailing the focus phonemes and the tricky words children will be learning in school. Please spend 5 minutes each day practising.

Please work on the Summer 2 Key instant recall facts (KIRFs) for maths— we ask that you work on these with your child for 5 minutes each day.

Pretend to be a weather reporter! Make a short video or give a weather report to your family.

## **Survival of the Fittest**

**Choose a hot or cold environment. Create your own made up animal and label how it is suited and has adapted to live in that environment.**

Find or draw pictures of animals, clothes, or places. Sort them into two groups: hot places and cold places.

Be inspired by your favourite fairy tales. Can you innovate and create one of your own?
