

Homework - Year 1 Spring 2 2026

Every Week

Each week a list of words from the common exception spellings from Year 1 will be sent home for children to learn. At the end of each half term, children will be given a spelling test of 10 random words from the list.

Children will bring home a reading book that they have practised and rehearsed in school. Please listen to their reading so that they can showcase it to you— we ask that you read for 10 minutes each day.

Children will bring home a library book that they have chosen. This is an unfamiliar text that should be read to them. Please encourage enjoyment through looking at the pictures and talking about the book.

Each week a Little Wandle home learning sheet will be shared, detailing the focus phonemes and the tricky words children will be learning in school. Please spend 5 minutes each day practising.

A letter will be sent to explain Key Instant Recall Facts (KIRFs) for maths— we ask that you work on these with your child for 5 minutes each day.
