Every Week

This half term we will be sending home a list of spelling rules with relevant spellings which the children should revise in readiness for their upcoming SATs.

Children will bring home an accelerated reading book at their reading level. They are able to quiz in school and change their book as soon as they have quizzed. Please read for a minimum of 20 minutes each day.

Every Friday, children will be set a homework task for maths and GPS/reading— this should be returned to school by the following Wednesday and should take around 30 minutes per week.

Children will be given a login to TTRS (Times Tables Rock Stars) In Year 6 children are expected to know up to 12x tables. We ask that children complete 20 minutes of games across the week.

In the build-up to SATs, we encourage the children to revise. The children can use their monster learning login or use other materials they have available to them.

Healthy Heart Campaign



Create a short video or poster explaining how to keep your heart healthy. Include tips (exercise, diet, sleep).

This could be filmed or made as a slideshow with voiceover.

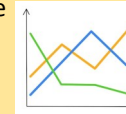
'Be the Blood' Comic Strip

Create a comic showing a red blood cell travelling through the body. Include key parts: heart → lungs → body → back to heart. Add speech bubbles and humour.



Fitness Investigation

Measure heart rate before and after exercise. You could make this a comparative investigation and do with family or friends too! Record results in a table or graph (Excel or by hand).



Build a Human Heart

Use materials of your choice to create a model of the human heart. Label the key parts of the heart or create a video showing them on your model.

Journey of a Product



Pick an everyday item (e.g. chocolate, trainers, bananas). Trace where it comes from and how it travels to the UK. Create a PowerPoint, Google Slides, or Canva presentation. Include maps, images, and facts about each country.

'A Day in the Life' Writing Task

Write a diary entry from the perspective of someone involved in trade (e.g. farmer, factory worker, ship captain, shop owner). Focus on how trade affects their daily life. Can be handwritten or typed.

Currency Conversion Challenge

Research currencies from 3–5 countries that trade with the UK. Find out what currency they use and find out the conversion rate to British pounds.



Import/Export Photo Project

Take photos of items around your home. Research where they come from. Create a photo collage or slideshow showing global connections.
