Homework - Year 6 Autumn 1 2025

Each half term a list of words from the common exception spellings from Years 5/6 will be sent home for children to learn. At the end of each half term, children will be given a spelling test on the words from the list.

Children will bring home an accelerated reading book at their reading level. They are able to quiz in school and change their book as soon as they have quizzed. Please read for a minimum of 20 minutes each day.

Every Friday, children will be set a homework task for maths and GPS—this should be returned to school by the following Wednesday and should take around 30 minutes per week. Children will be given a login to TTRS (Times Tables Rock Stars) In Year 6 children are expected to know up to 12x tables. We ask that children complete 20 minutes of games across the week.

A letter will be sent to explain Key Instant Recall Facts (KIRFs) for maths— we ask that you work on these with your child for at least 5 minutes each day.

Research a famous Victorian.

Then produce a fact file or biography about the person.

Create a family tree for Queen Victoria.

Design a Victorian themed menu.

Think about the types of food
they ate.

Find out about the toys that
Victorian children played with.
Design or make a toy that a
Victorian child may have played
with.

Design a Victorian outfit.

Consider whether your outfit is
for a rich person or a poor
person.

You could use your sewing skills to make a garment of clothing.

Create a poster about electrical safety.

Make it appropriate for a younger child to help them stay safe!

Conduct experiments with static electricity, such as using a balloon to pick up small pieces of paper or seeing how static electricity builds up over time.

Investigate the impact of electricity: research and present on how electricity is used in our daily lives and the importance of electrical safety.
