

Homework - Year 3 Summer 2 2026

Every Week

Each half term a list of words from the common exception spellings from the Year 3 & 4 list will be sent home to learn. At the end of each half term, children will be given a spelling test on the words from the list.

Children will bring home an accelerated reading book at their reading level. They are able to quiz in school and change their book as soon as they have quizzed. Please read for a minimum of 20 minutes each day.

Every Friday, children will be set a homework task in their Maths Practice Journal—this should be returned to school by the following Wednesday and should take around 30 minutes per week.

Children will be given a login to TTRS (Times Tables Rock Stars) Teachers will set the times tables children need to practise. We ask that children complete 20 minutes of games across the week.

Please use the Summer 2 Key Instant Recall Facts (KIRFs) for maths— we ask that you work on these with your child for at least 5 minutes each day.

Choose a selection each half term

Make or draw your own mythical creature and give it an exciting name.

Research a Greek philosopher such as Pluto, Aristotle, Archimedes or Pythagoras

Make some traditional Greek dishes such as moussaka or a Greek salad.

Look at images of Greek pots, plates and patterns. Draw or paint a Greek scene suitable for a vase or plate

Build a Greek temple:
Make a model from cardboard, Lego, or recycled materials.

Reflective materials test:
Find 5 household objects and predict which will reflect light best.
Shine a torch and rank them from “most shiny” to “least shiny.”

Create an animal or character shadow puppet and test it with a torch.

Shadow detective:
Draw or photograph the same object's shadow at three different times of day.
Write or discuss: What changed? Why?
