Every Week

Each half term a list of words from the common exception spellings from the Year 3 & 4 list will be sent home to learn. At the end of each half term, children will be given a spelling test on the words from the list.

Children will bring home an accelerated reading book at their reading level. They are able to quiz in school and change their book as soon as they have quizzed. Please read for a minimum of 20 minutes each day.

Every Friday, children will be set a homework task in their Maths Practice Journal—this should be returned to school by the following Wednesday and should take around 30 minutes per week.

Children will be given a login to TTRS (Times Tables Rock Stars) Teachers will set the times tables children need to practise. We ask that children complete 20 minutes of games across the week.

Please use the Summer 1 Key Instant Recall Facts (KIRFs) for maths— we ask that you work on these with your child for at least 5 minutes each day.

Design your own chocolate bar and wrapper.

Write a fact file about the history of chocolate.

Research and design a poster about fair trade.

Research and draw the stages of cocoa beans to chocolate.

Create a colourful poster showing:
What deforestation is
Why it happens
How we can help

Add labels to explain the changes.
