Homework - Year 3 Spring 1 2026



Each half term a list of words from the common exception spellings from the Year 3 & 4 list will be sent home to learn. At the end of each half term, children will be given a spelling test on the words from the list.

Children will bring home an accelerated reading book at their reading level. They are able to quiz in school and change their book as soon as they have quizzed. Please read for a minimum of 20 minutes each day.

Every Friday, children will be set a homework task in their Maths Practice Journal—this should be returned to school by the following Wednesday and should take around 30 minutes per week.

Children will be given a login to TTRS (Times Tables Rock Stars) Teachers will set the times tables children need to practise. We ask that children complete 20 minutes of games across the week.

A letter will be sent to explain Key Instant Recall Facts (KIRFs) for maths—we ask that you work on these with your child for at least 5 minutes each day.

Choose a selection each half term

Use the internet to find out about a metal of your choice. Make a list of facts.

Investigate what happens to tarnished pennies when soaked in vinegar, coke or lemon juice.

Look around your home and find 10 small objects. Test which ones are magnetic and non-magnetic.



Can you spot five things you do at home that need a push or a pull? Put each action into the correct group to show whether it is a push or a pull force.

Design your own Bronze or Iron Age settlement in a medium of your choice.



Cut and arrange foil shapes to create a collage of the Iron Man.



Imagine you are an archaeologist and you have just discovered a Bronze Age site! Draw 3 objects that might have been used.



Research some of the tasks carried out by robots. What tasks could robots do in your house?
