

Homework - Reception Summer 2 2026

Every Week

Each week a Little Wandle home learning sheet will be shared, detailing the focus phonemes and the tricky words children will be learning in school.
Please spend 5 minutes each day practising.

Children will bring home a reading book that they have practised and rehearsed in school. Please listen to their reading so that they can showcase it to you.
We ask that you read for 10 minutes each day.

Write in child's reading record.

Children will bring home a library book that they have chosen. This is an unfamiliar text that should be read to them.
Please encourage enjoyment through looking at the pictures and talking about the book.

For maths, please refer to the KIRFs homework sheet for Summer 2 solving addition and subtraction problems, read and solve addition and subtraction number sentences

Upload on to Tapestry.

Choose a selection each half term

Go on a nature hunt and collect or draw four things you find outdoors, such as a leaf, stick, pebble, or flower.

Upload on to Tapestry

Look for shapes outside and draw or photograph at least three different shapes that you can find.

Discuss or label their properties.

Upload on to Tapestry

Keep a simple weather diary for one week and record whether each day is sunny, cloudy, rainy, or windy.

Bring into school

Search for minibeasts in your garden or local park and draw your favourite one

Write a sentence to describe it.

Bring into school

Collect some leaves and create leaf rubbings using paper and crayons.

Bring in to school

Draw a picture of your favourite outdoor place or upload a photograph to Tapestry and tell us why it is special to you.

Upload on to Tapestry or bring into school.

Pretend you are spending a day at the seaside and draw or write about what you would do there.

Bring in to school

Make a boat using recycled materials and bring in a photograph or drawing of your creation
