

Homework - Reception Summer 1 2026

Every Week

Each week a Little Wandle home learning sheet will be shared, detailing the focus phonemes and the tricky words children will be learning in school. Please spend 5 minutes each day practising.

Children will bring home a reading book that they have practised and rehearsed in school. Please listen to their reading so that they can showcase it to you. We ask that you read for 10 minutes each day.

Children will bring home a library book that they have chosen. This is an unfamiliar text that should be read to them. Please encourage enjoyment through looking at the pictures and talking about the book.

For maths, please refer to the KIRFs homework sheet for Summer 1 with the focus on recognising numerals to 20 and learning our number bonds to 10.

Write in child's reading record.

Choose a selection each half term

Invent your own superhero name. Encourage simple sentence writing: *"I am Super Sam. I help people."*

Draw a picture of community helpers (e.g. police, doctor, teacher).

Label them and write one thing they do.

Create a superhero shield using different shapes.

Name the shapes used (circle, square, triangle).

Perform a short "superhero rescue" at home.

Write a simple thank-you note to a real-life superhero (e.g. bin collector, nurse, parent).

Bring in to school

Build something from junk modelling (boxes, tubes).
