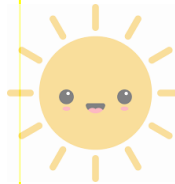

### Children's Behaviour - Course for Parents

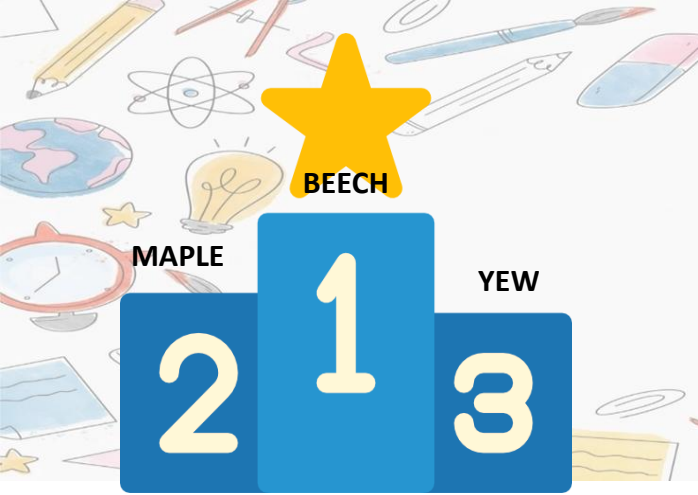

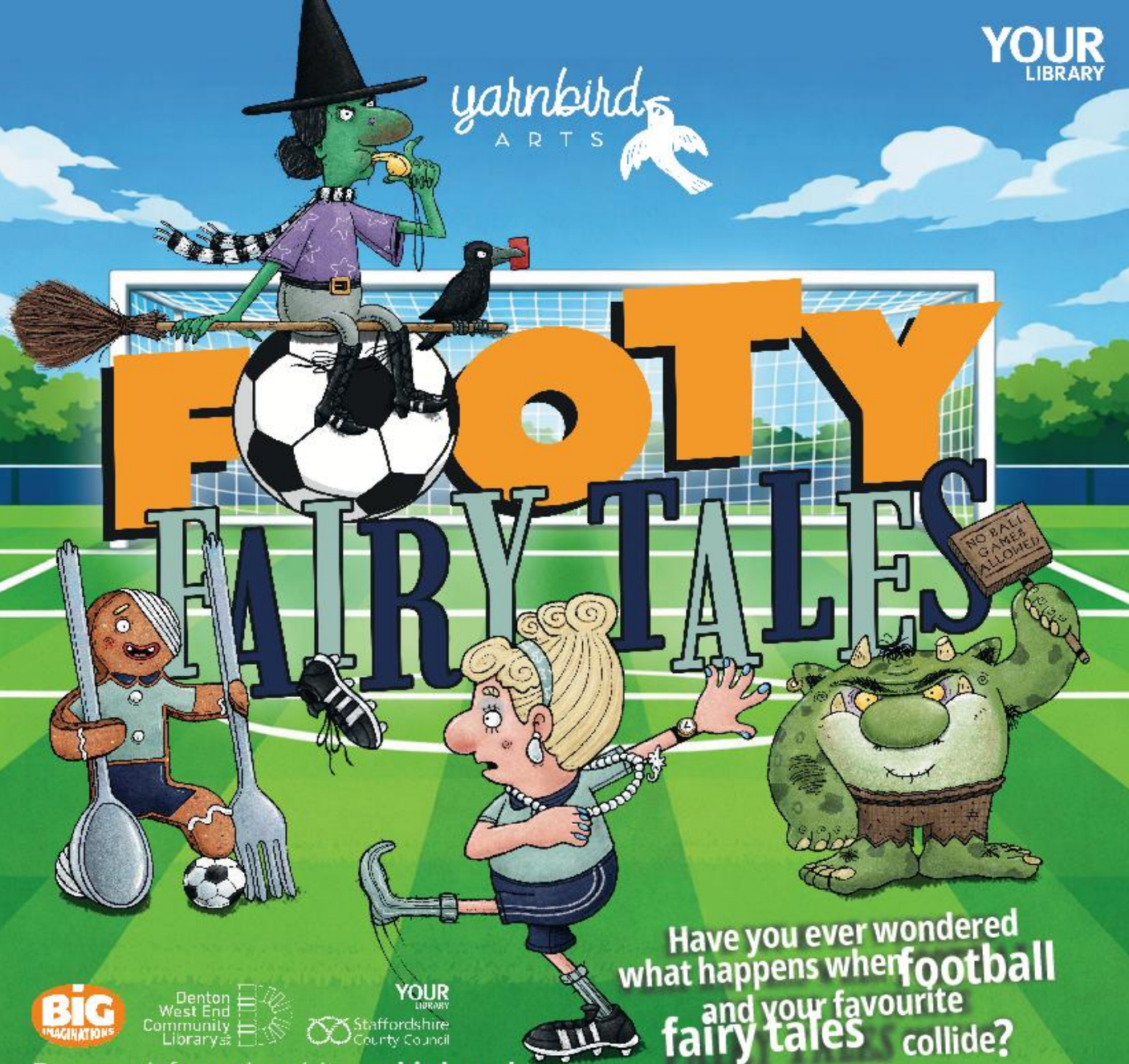
